With the mission to decrease pollution in our environment, we will build a strong fellowship with SOLV Beach Clean Up and Oregon Fish and Wildlife. Our chapter will work diligently with SOLV Beach Clean Up to improve the wildlife habitat stability along the Oregon coast line. There are several facets including picking up garbage on the beach, working with the marine centers to encourage boaters in reducing water pollution, and working side by side with Oregon Fish and Wildlife to restrict public access to the aquatic bird nesting habitat.
