

# Tillamook Toolbox Training

July 29-31, 2010

Tillamook, OR

Check out your favorite hobby or activity. In most cases, it involves a set of “tools”—it can be as simple as a crochet hook and yarn or as complex as one of those five-layer, fold-out, graduated tackle boxes some fishing fanatics carry. And don't get me started on woodworking or scrapbooking! Having a successful Phi Theta Kappa chapter requires a few tools as well, and here is where you can get them!

Join us the evening of Thursday, **July 29** (arrive as early as 5:00 pm) through about noon on Saturday, **July 31** at Tillamook Bay Community College for some skill building and lively fellowship. Some of the topics will be a Myer-Briggs assessment, Phi Theta Kappa Programs, Action Plans, SMART activities, and Poster tips.

**Lodging** has been reserved at Western Royal Motel, 1125 N Main St (that's Hwy 101), Tillamook, OR 97141. The cost for lodging is \$79 + tax for up to three, \$10 more for a fourth in a room. You may call them at: 503-842-8844 to reserve a room until July 23 for this special rate. If you prefer motel with a pool, you can call Mar Clair (11 Main Ave, at the junction of 101 and Hwy 6 next to the Shell station) for either \$60 or \$70 for a room. You may call 503-842-7571 to reserve. Be sure to mention Phi Theta Kappa in either case to get the special rate. If lodging costs would prevent you from coming, there is room at the Ocean Breeze Baptist Missionary Wing—ask Barb about this special option.

The **registration fee** will be \$35 and will include Friday Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner and Saturday Breakfast. **Thursday evening meal** will be a **POTLUCK** so bring your best dish to share. Please let us know if you have special dietary requirements.

To reach Tillamook Bay Community College, 4301 Third Street, Tillamook, OR:

*From the south:* Come up Hwy 101 to Tillamook. The second stop light will be 3<sup>rd</sup> St. Turn right. Get in the right lane. Follow signs “to Tillamook Bay Community College” bearing right at Y. The college will be on your right at the west end of the Fairgrounds. If you get to the main Fair pavilion with the big cheese out in front, turn around and go back to the college.

*From the north:* Come up Hwy 101 to Tillamook. The second stop light will be 3<sup>rd</sup> St. Turn left and get in the right lane. Follow signs “to Tillamook Bay Community College” bearing right at Y. The college will be on your right at the west end of the fairgrounds.

*From the east:* From Portland area, go west on Hwy 26 to the junction at Hwy 6. Bear left. Keep going over hill and dale until you get the Tillamook area. Just after you leave the canyon, you will come to a weigh station on your right and shortly afterwards a yellow blinking light. Turn left at the light (Wilson River Loop). At the top of the hill, (Third Street) you will see the fairgrounds. Turn Right. You will see the college building a block away on your left.
