Description of the Award

This award will be presented to a Phi Theta Kappa member with the most outstanding art entry related to the current year's Honors Study Topic, "The Democratization of Information: Power, Peril, and Promise," at the Regional Convention. Consideration will be given to originality, presentation, creativity, technique and skill with the medium, clarity of idea, and overall effect.

Entry Specifications

The entry must be an original design. The artist may select the medium of his or her choice, with the exception of video. A 3" x 5" card explaining the relationship to or depiction of the Honors Study Topic must accompany the work. The artist must supply any equipment or material that is necessary to display the work at the Regional Convention. Access to electrical outlets cannot be provided.

This entry form must be received by the Regional Coordinator by April 6, 2012, for the work to be eligible for the award. The work itself must be brought or delivered to the Regional Convention by the scheduled start of the opening session. A copy of this form must be attached to the work.

The host chapter and Phi Theta Kappa RMC Region shall assume no liability for loss or damage to works submitted for this award; however, every effort will be made to protect works submitted from damage or loss.
