This award is presented to the chapter with the best overall chapter yearbook. Judging is based on the following criteria:

1. Does the yearbook tell a cogent story of the chapter's activities over the year? (30%)
2. Does the yearbook convey a sense of who the active chapter officers, members and advisor were? (25%)
3. Does the yearbook include information about all four Hallmarks? (20%)
4. Where appropriate, does the yearbook include information about other chapter activities such as planning sessions, fund raisers, and social events? (15%)
5. Was the yearbook itself creatively done and well constructed with an attractive layout and an inviting cover? (10%)

Entry Specifications

This entry form must be received by the Regional Coordinator by April 2, 2010, for the chapter's yearbook to be eligible for the award. The yearbook itself must be brought or delivered to the Regional Convention by the scheduled start the opening session. A copy of this form must be attached to the cover of the yearbook.
